Report of the Duxbury and Cohasset Railroad Company:  
"The directors respectfully present to the stockholders their first annual report of the Duxbury and Cohasset Railroad Company."

The road was located from ~~distant~~<sup>its</sup> intersections with the South Shore Railroad in Cohasset to its terminus in South Duxbury, a distance of seventeen and one half miles and ground was broken on the seventeenth of December 1870. On the fifteenth of June 1871 the road was in operation to South Scituate, a distance of about six and one quarter miles, and on the seventeenth of August 1871 just eight months from the breaking of ground it was so far completed as to be opened through to public travel."
