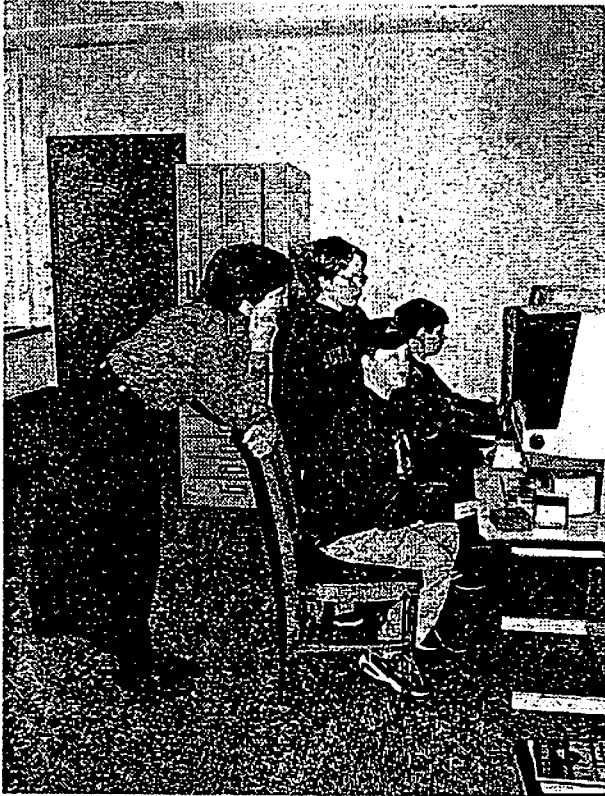

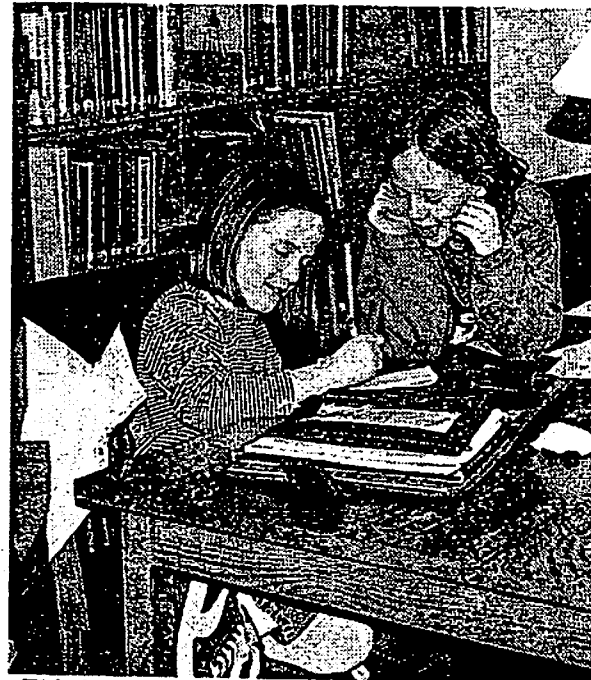

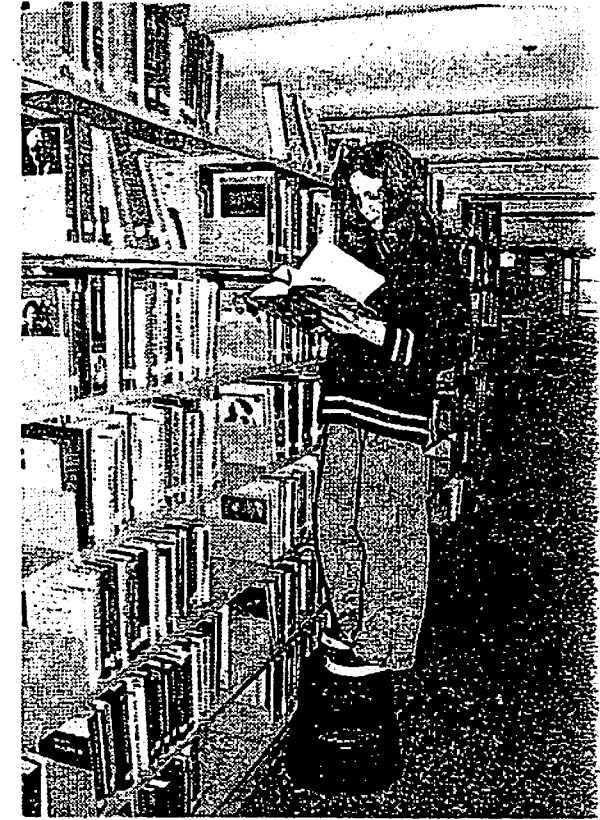

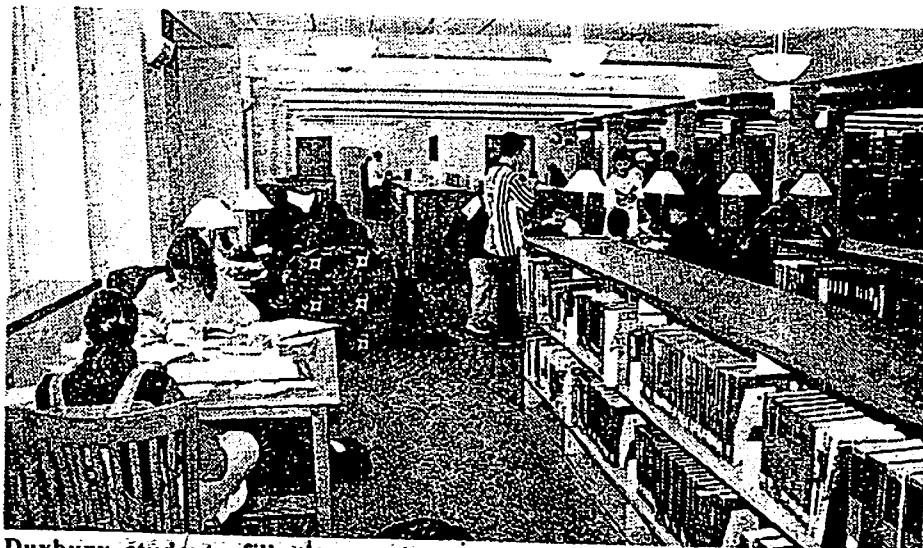
Ellen Snoeyenbos, young adult librarian, helps students locate articles in back issues of *The New York Times* on the microfilm machine.



Third graders Molly Horan and Elissa Heckendorf work on their homework.



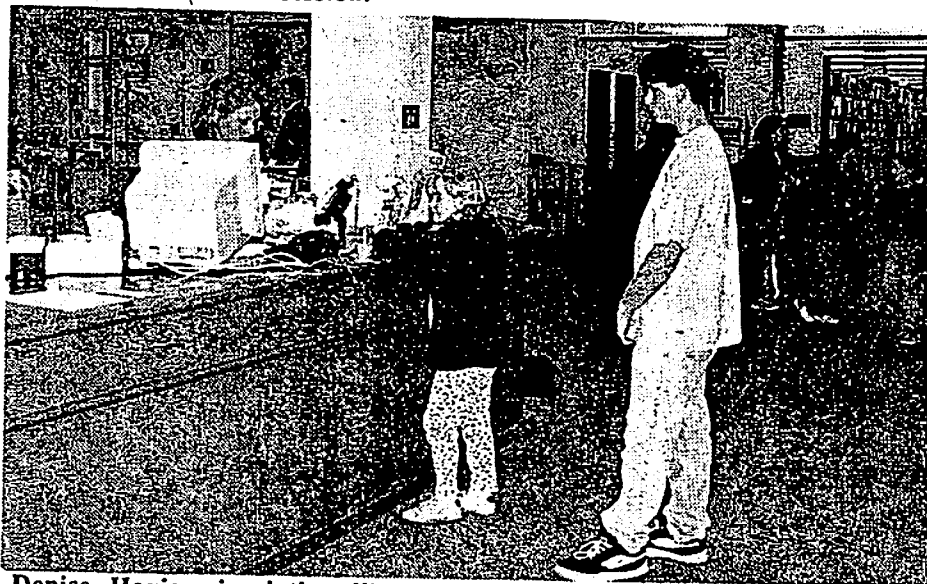
Jeanna Moody stands atop a stool to pursue her research project in the Duxbury Free Library.



Duxbury students fill the spacious new Duxbury Free Library during a recent classroom session.



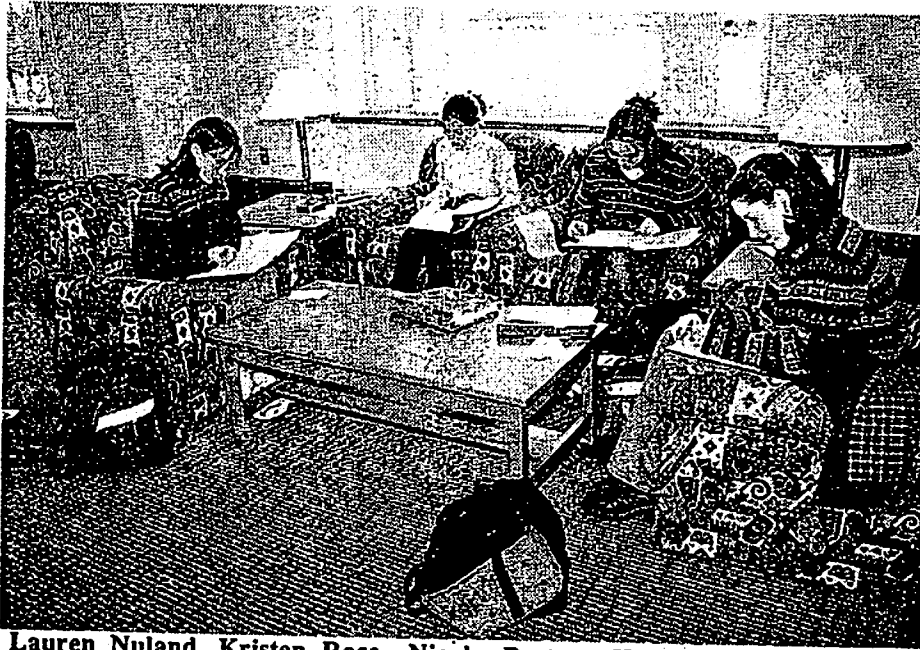

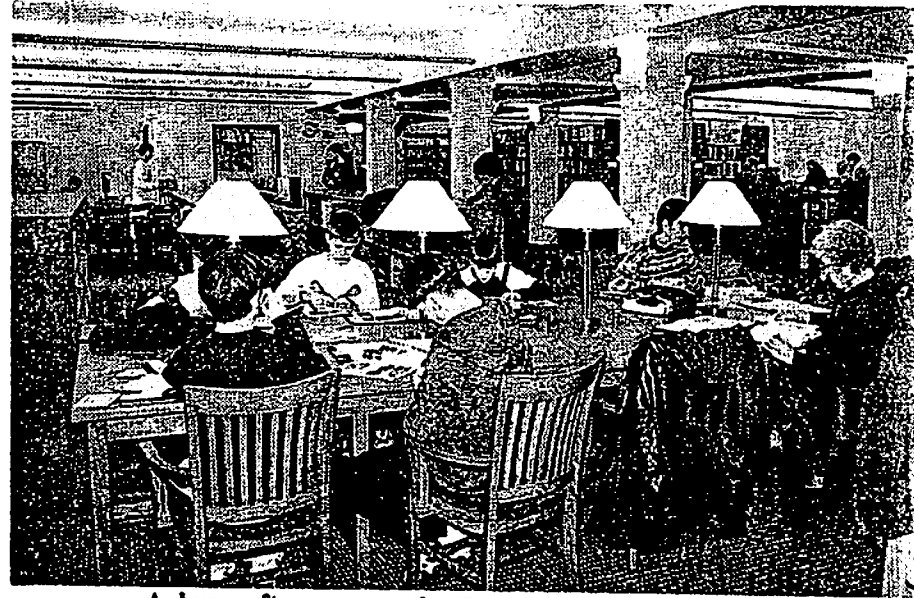
