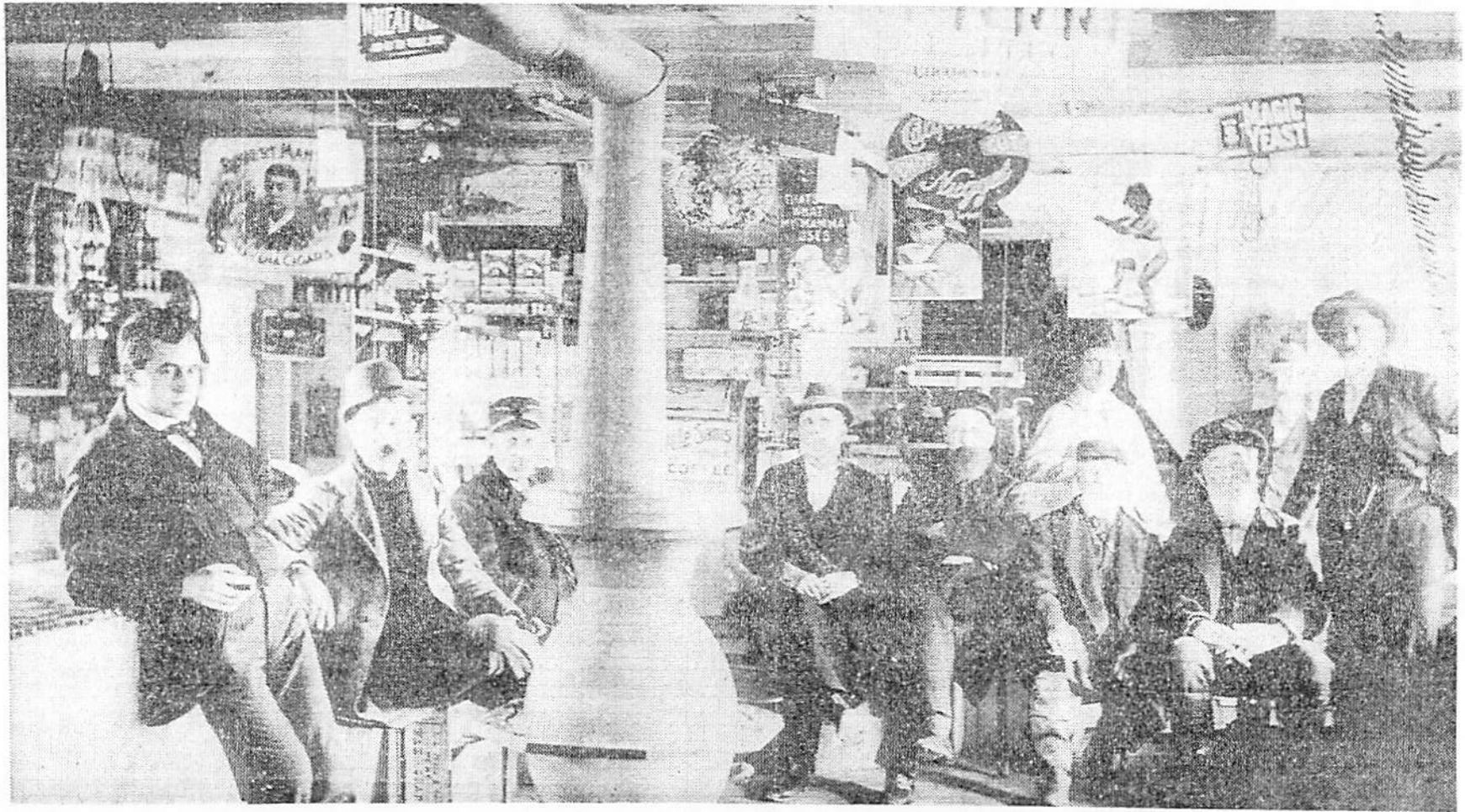


Some of Duxbury's Best Known Citizens Shown In A 1901 Scene



The Water Prince house on Washington St. was once a store operated by Windsor & Peterson and, earlier, by Mr. Peterson, when it was known as the W. O. Peterson Store. The scene above, which appears on the 1960 calendar of Toabe's Duxbury Hardware Company, shows some of the local residents inside the W. O. Peterson Store in 1901.

L. to r, Smith the Barber; Frank Holmes, Joseph Soule, James K. Burgess, a boat-builder; Deputy Sheriff William Alden, Samuel Richards, Harry Tammatt, a clerk, is shown behind Sam and Louis Windsor, a fisherman who owned the John Cutler house on Washington St. (once known as "The Cookie House"). In the back of Louis is W. O. Peterson, the proprietor, and Joshua M. Cushing, an auctioneer and realtor.
